

Revision Sheet for Music Assessment

Your assessment will consist of two parts – a performance of Lazy Latin on Chime Bars and a written assessment where you have to **name** the notes of the Treble Clef.

There are two different kinds of notes in Music:

- A note “on a line”  (the line cuts the note through the middle)
- A note “in a space”  (the note floats in the middle between two lines)

Treble Clef Notes:

Rhyme for lines: **E**very **G**ood **B**oy **D**eserves **F**ootball




Rhyme for spaces spells: **F** **A** **C** **E**



Remember, you need to always count upwards from the **bottom line or space** – think of the staff like a **ladder** that you have to climb up from the lowest rung.

Finally, there will also be some notes that don't fit on the staff. You need to learn **TWO** notes **below** and **TWO** notes **above** the staff.



The rhyme for these notes is – **C**ows **D**on't **G**et **A**ngry.
