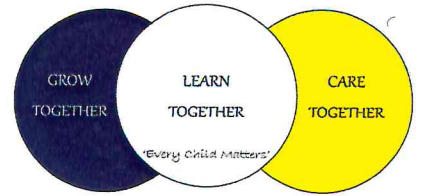

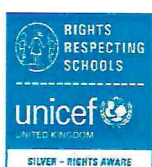
I am proposing the following arrangements for the week:
