Updating your C2k password on personal devices

When your C2k password has been changed in school, access to applications like Outlook or MySchool from home may be restricted.

A student will need to change the saved password on their personal devices manually. To do this:

Apple devices

- 1. Open the Settings App
- 2. Scroll down and the open Passwords section (They may be asked for their face or passcode to open this)
- 3. Scroll to C
- You will see c2kschools.net listed. Click on the Edit option (top right) then delete all passwords saved for c2kschools.net
- 5. Open Myschool or any other school App
- 6. You will be asked for a password, enter the new one
- 7. When prompted, click update saved passwords

Android devices

- 1. Open settings
- 2. Autofill
- 3. Passwords (scroll down and you will see all saved passwords)
- 4. All passwords related to school will show C2ken.net under the website section.
- 5. Click the 3 dots beside this password and then remove
- 6. Open Myschool or any other school App
- 7. You will be asked for a password, enter the new one
- 8. When prompted, click update saved passwords

The above steps for Android can also be done when using a Chrome Browser by clicking on the 3 dots under the X to close the page.
